**Eligibility/Seeding:** USCSA Conference Ski Teams, USSA Seniors, USSA J1, J2, J3. Only **one** Scoring Team from each college is seeded according to coach's discretion. **Individual** competitors (anyone not seeded) will start according to their USSA points. All athletes must have a current USSA License to participate.

**Entry Procedure:** Each Team Captain must submit one USSA Team Entry Form per gender. Only one team per college is seeded according to coach's discretion.

**Entry Deadline:** **WEDNESDAY, February 1<sup>st</sup> by 5pm** (\$50 late fee per team).
